



# 18' Boat Rigging Tips!

Ceiba's 18' boats can carry a 205 Qt Galaxy Cooler with 6 - 12, 20mm cans in each drop bag &/or milk crates, propane tanks &/or soda pop / beer

Ceiba's Rig Bag is included with all of our full rigs & contains:

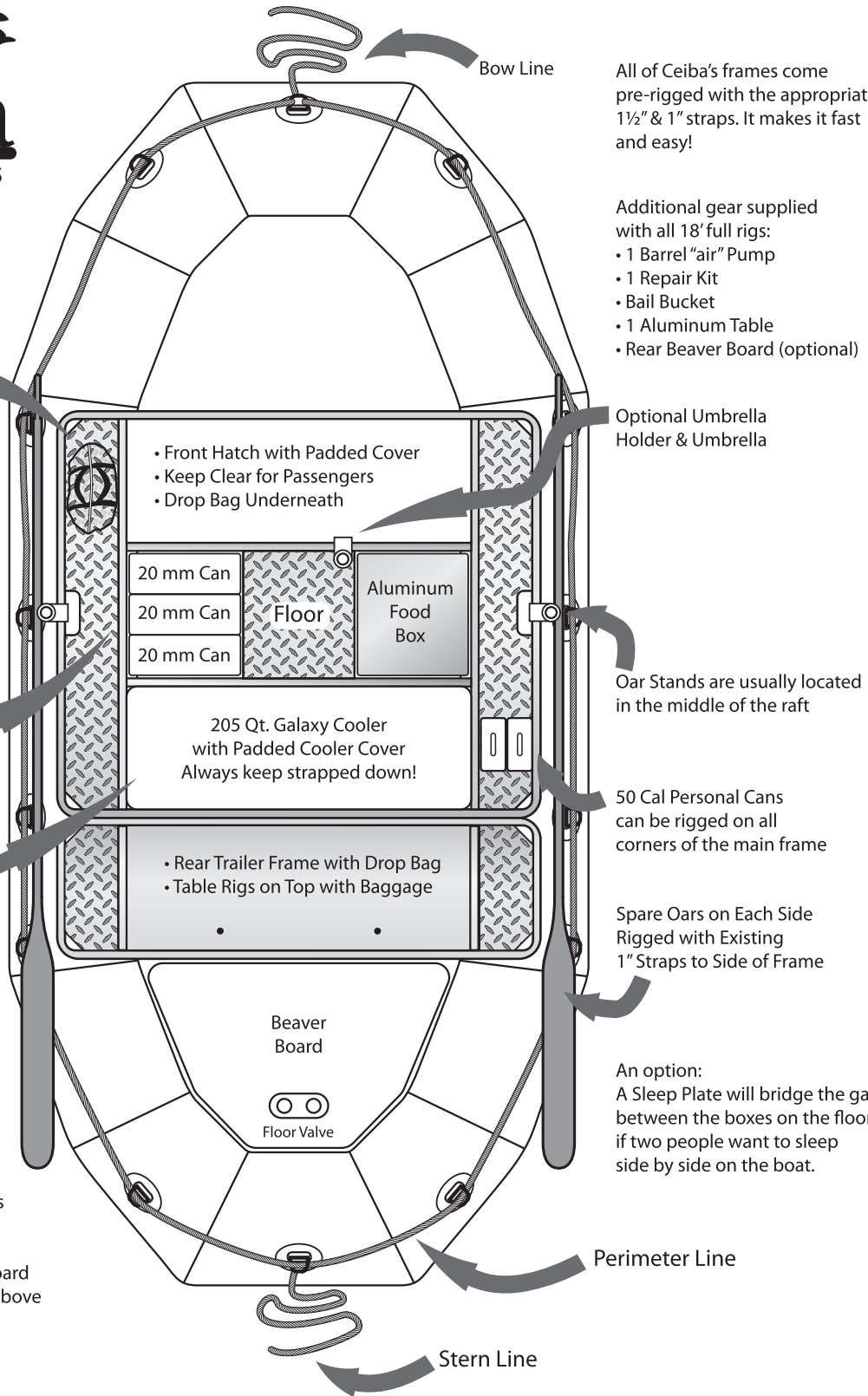
- 15 Extra Rigging Straps
- 1 Throw Cushion
- 1 Throw Bag
- 3 Oar Stands & Locks
- Sand Anchor & Hammer
- Drag Bag for beverages
- Custom Woody Allen!

3 - 20mm cans or 1 Aluminum Box can fit on either side of the floor

All of Ceiba's 18' Boats come with the best cooler made: The 205 Qt Galaxy along with a cooler cover!

#### TIPS:

- Rinse feet off before getting on the boat
- Please do not write on boats
- No Duct Tape please
- Keep sand out of valves
- Aluminum floor & Beaver Board should be rigged about 1" above the Self-Bailing floor

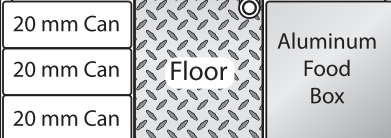


All of Ceiba's frames come pre-rigged with the appropriate 1½" & 1" straps. It makes it fast and easy!

- Additional gear supplied with all 18' full rigs:
- 1 Barrel "air" Pump
  - 1 Repair Kit
  - Bail Bucket
  - 1 Aluminum Table
  - Rear Beaver Board (optional)

Optional Umbrella Holder & Umbrella

- Front Hatch with Padded Cover
- Keep Clear for Passengers
- Drop Bag Underneath

- Rear Trailer Frame with Drop Bag
- Table Rigs on Top with Baggage

Oar Stands are usually located in the middle of the raft

But deep down all boatmen know there is a certain amount of truth spoken each time the phrase passes the lips of a Grand Canyon boater. With good reason too! The last thing any boater wants on his or her boat is a "junk show" or "yard sale". As we all know, anything can happen and the sayings are endless! But, they are there for a reason.

We recommend rigging to flip every morning. Above, is a Boat Rigging Tips diagram that can help you and your teammates through out your adventure. The diagram is an over view of the boat, what it is equipped to hold, placement for gear and general tips for keeping a safe, fun and clean rig!
